ON THE JOB . . .



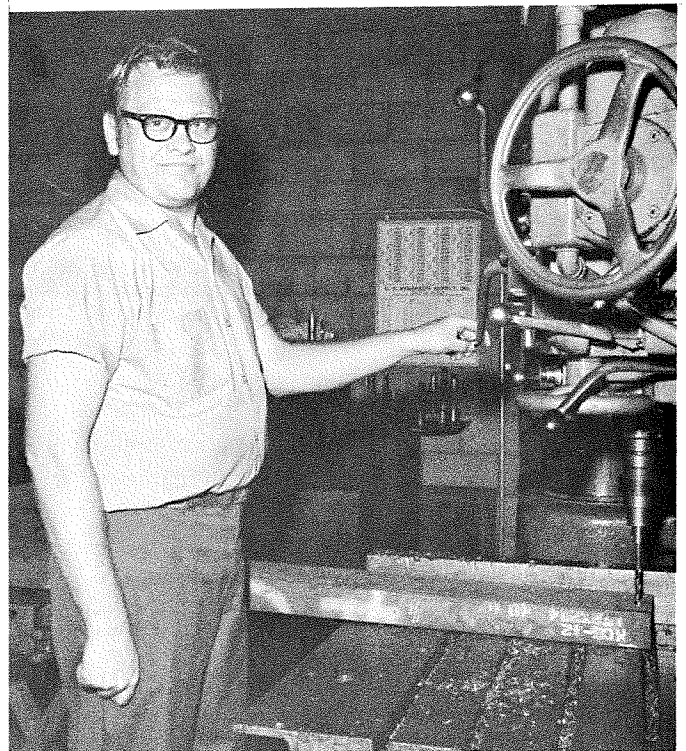
