LET'S PITCH IN AND HELP . . . Coal supplies at electrical utilities are dwindling due to the continuing coal strike. In line with Governor Bowen's request for voluntary reduction in electrical consumption, our company is taking appropriate action to reduce our consumption to the maximum extent possible without curtailing plant operations. Accordingly, all areas heated electrically will be maintained at 65° F in occupied areas and 40° F in unoccupied areas. Any unnecessary lighting and all electrical machinery not actually being used will be turned off. Our cooperation is needed during this emergency. Hopefully, we can prevent the need for mandatory curtailment of our electrical consumption, if the strike continues for an extended period.
