




GOOD THINKING, BOB! Machine Shop Foreman BOB KLUMP has come up with a redesign suggestion for Balcrank's Jet Power pump screen assembly.

The current method is to solder the screen to the top and bottom collars. Bob's suggestion features a groove in the primer cylinder to which a retaining ring will be attached. By assembling the screen assembly and inserting the primer cylinder, the screen can be tightened down by using the retainer as a stop.

The new method will add considerable ease to the replacement of this part in the field, not to mention the significant cost reduction.
