STRONG PERFORMANCE... Wheelabrator-Frye Inc. achieved record sales, net income and earnings per share in the third quarter and the first nine months of 1979.

Third-quarter sales were \$240,140,000, an increase of 19% from sales of \$202,062,000 in the July-September period of last year. Net income was \$11,668,000, up 14% from net income of \$10,222,000 in the corresponding period of 1978.

Sales in the first nine months climbed to \$696.278,000, an advance of 22% from sales of \$571,692,000 in the first three quarters of 1978. Net income rose to \$30,641,000, an increase of 16% from net income of \$26,349,000 in the January-September period of last year.

Michael D. Dingman, chairman of Wheelabrator-Frye, said the "strong performance reflected the well-balanced expansion of the company across the range of our businesses. Despite the obvious mounting concerns about the world economy, we expect 1979 to be another year of significant earnings growth for Wheelabrator-Frye."
