

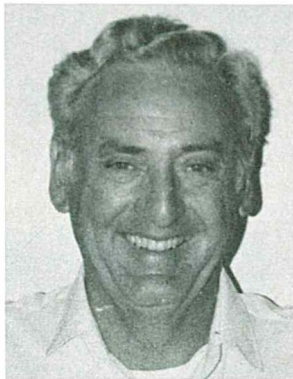

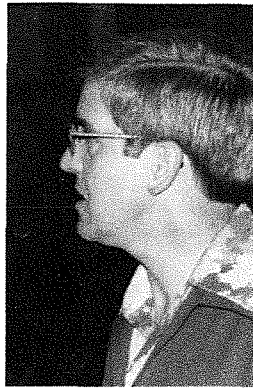
FRED, IT WON'T BE THE SAME . . .
